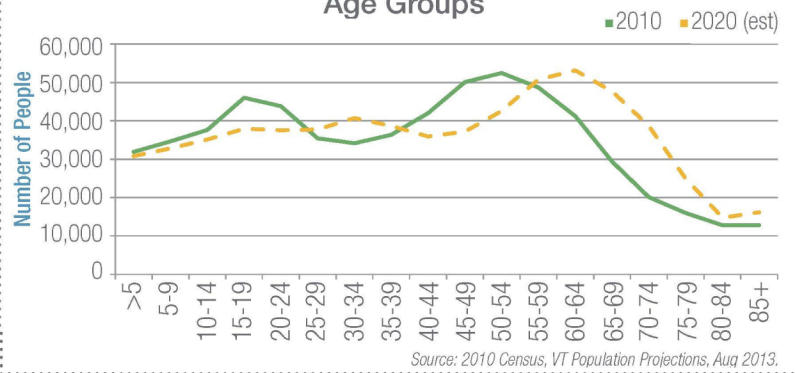

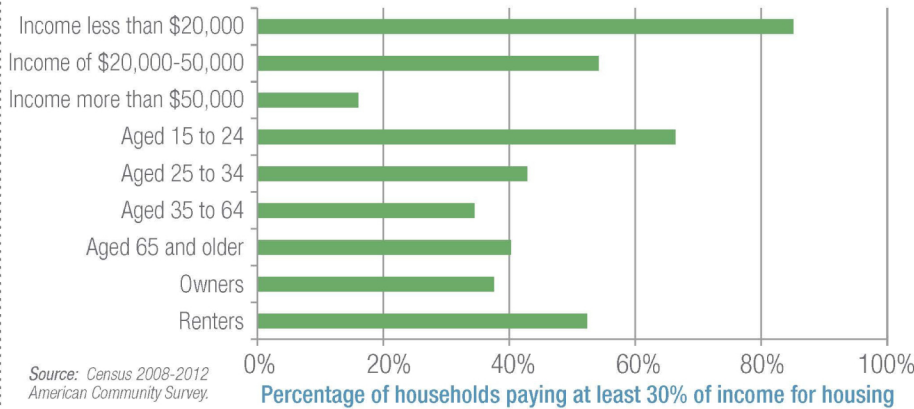
Percentage of Income Spent on Housing Expenses

\$19.36

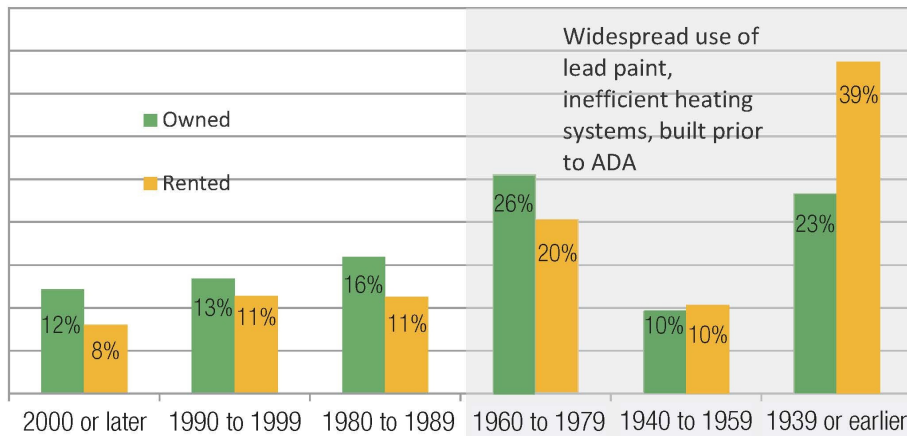

Affordability of Buying a Home



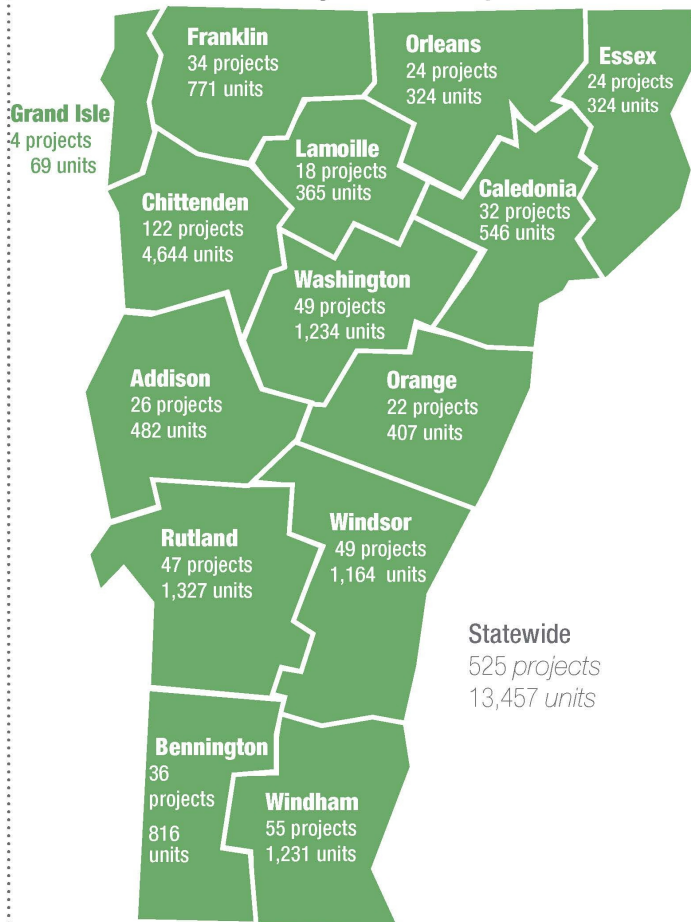
Age of Homes

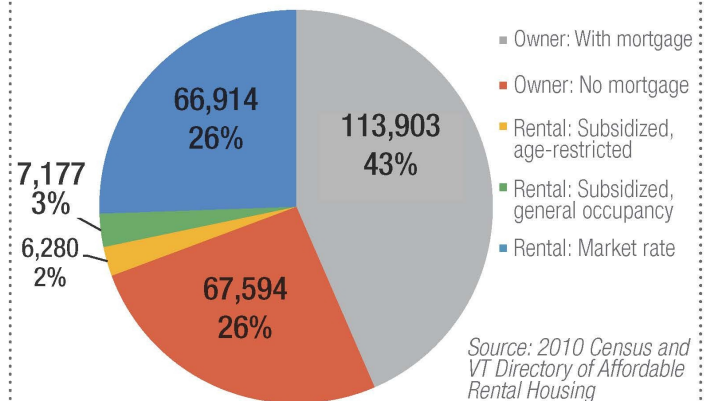


Affordable Multifamily Rental Properties and Units



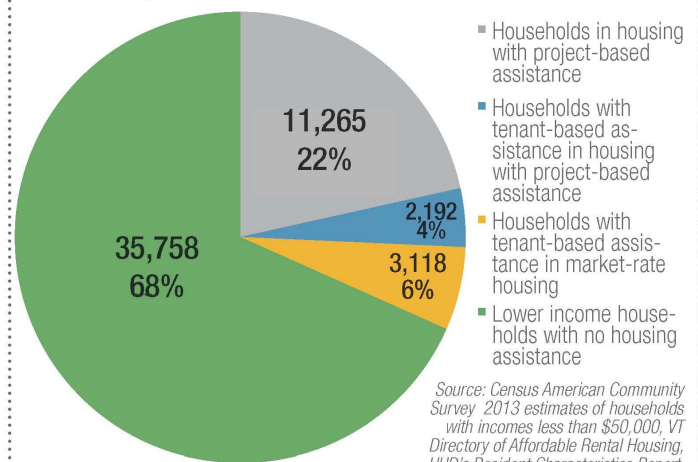
