

Dealing with drafts and high heating bills?

The Weatherization Repayment Assistance Program (WRAP) can help you pay for energy-saving home improvements over time on your existing utility bill, with low interest rates and low upfront costs.



What is the Weatherization Repayment Assistance Program (WRAP)?

WRAP is a state-funded program administered by Vermont Housing Finance Agency (VHFA). VHFA assists Vermonters with the up-front costs of home weatherization, which are paid back over time on your existing utility bill.

What home projects can WRAP help with?

Every WRAP project must include comprehensive weatherization such as adding insulation and air sealing, matched with your home's needs. Alongside weatherization work, WRAP can also finance heat pumps, electric water heaters and advanced wood heating systems.

Who is eligible?

- Homeowners and renters (with landlord approval)
- 12 months of positive utility bill payment history
- Homes served by Burlington Electric Department, Green Mountain Power, Ludlow Electric, Vermont Electric Coop and Vermont Gas Systems

How do I sign up?

WRAP Partners at Vermont Gas, BED and Efficiency VT will work with you on completing an energy audit to identify potential weatherization projects, estimate potential energy savings, and connect you with utility incentives. If your project meets screening criteria and you decide to move forward, they will work with you to complete an application and connect you with an approved contractor.
