

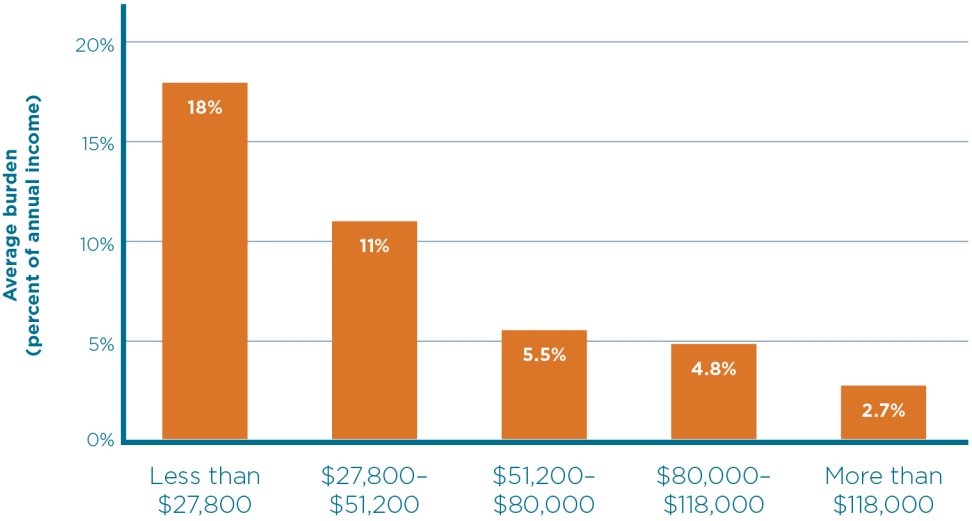

Combined heating and electricity energy burden in Vermont, by income quintile

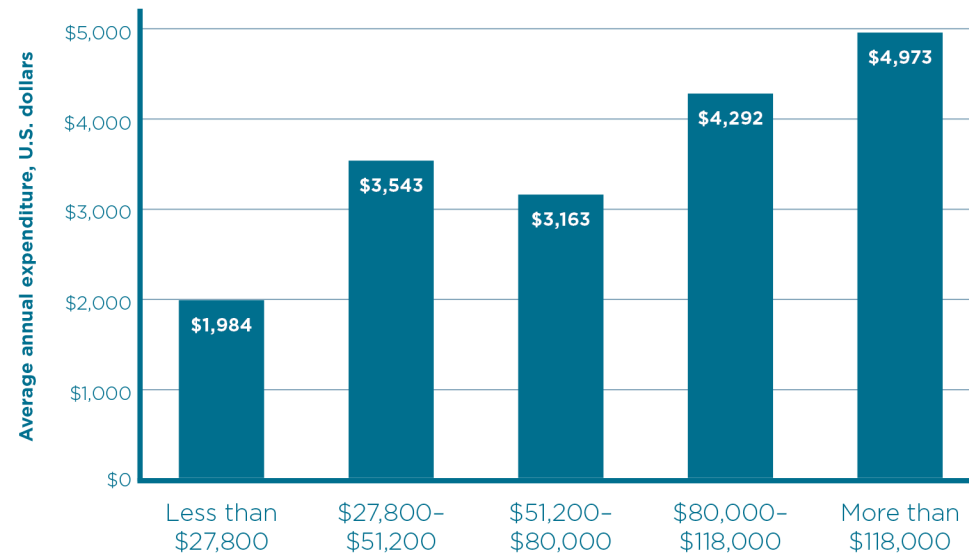

Energy expenditure by income

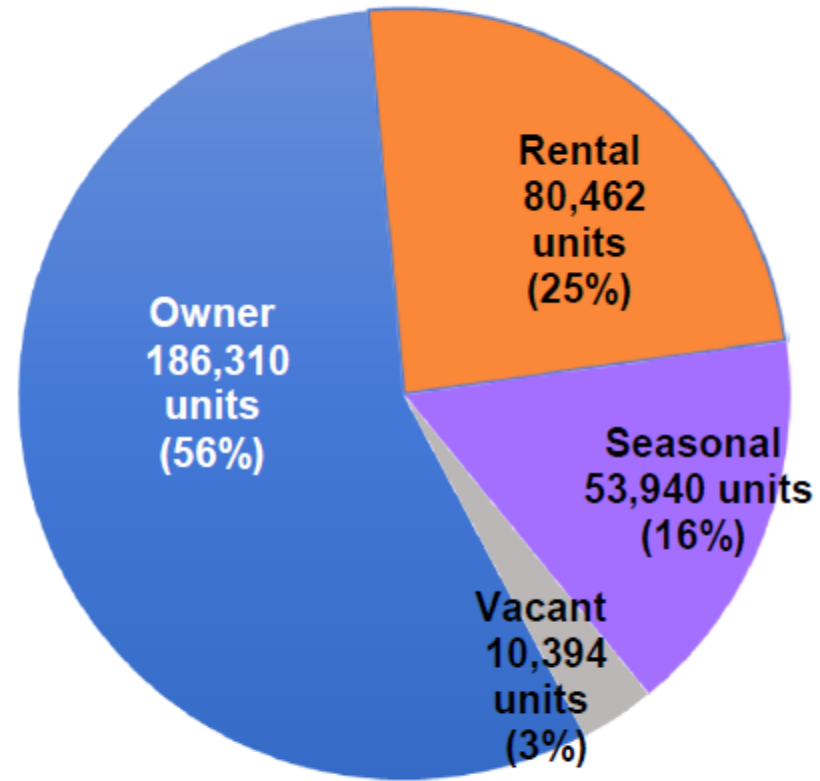
Combined heating and electricity expenditures in Vermont, by income quintile

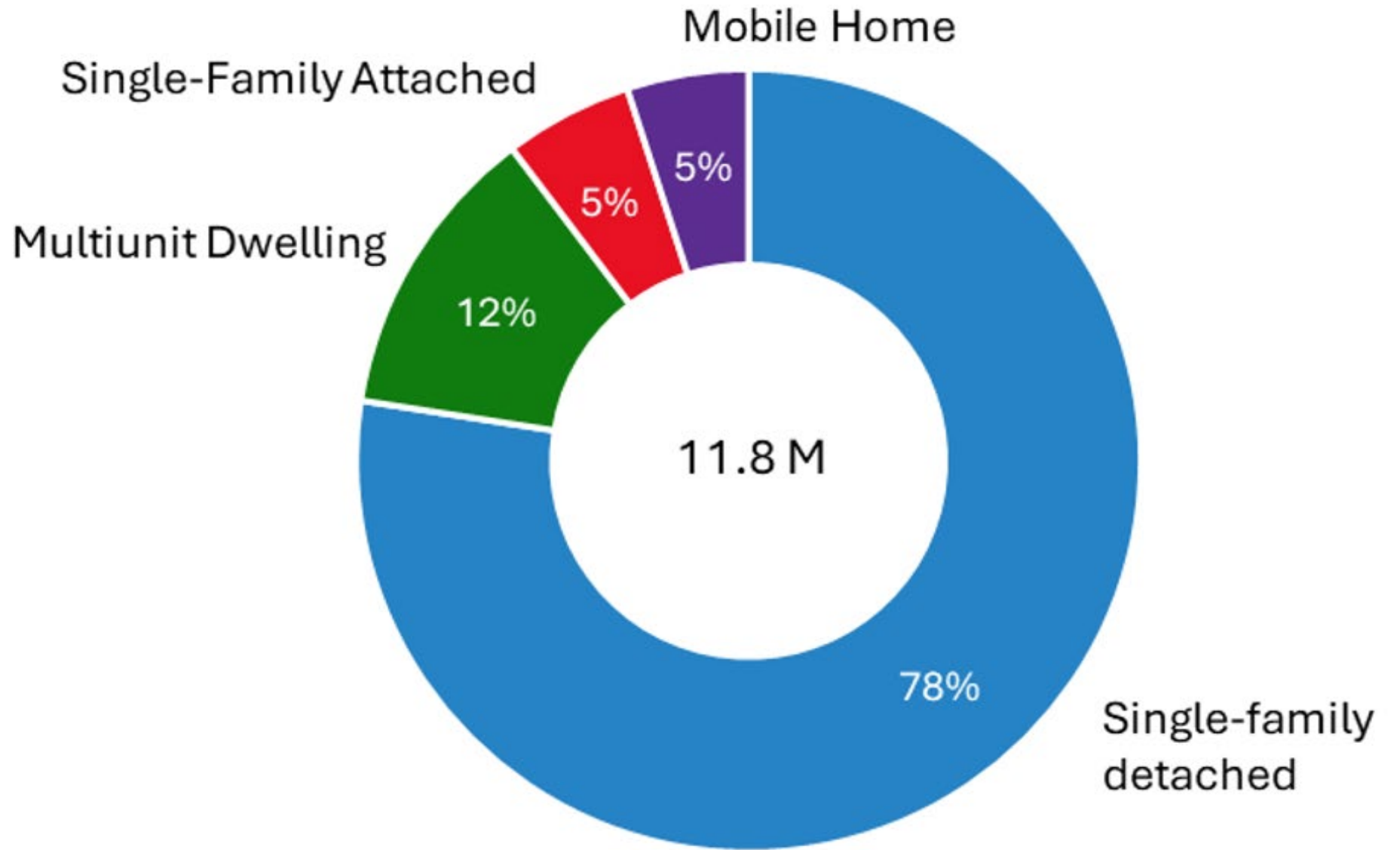


Estimated housing units by type

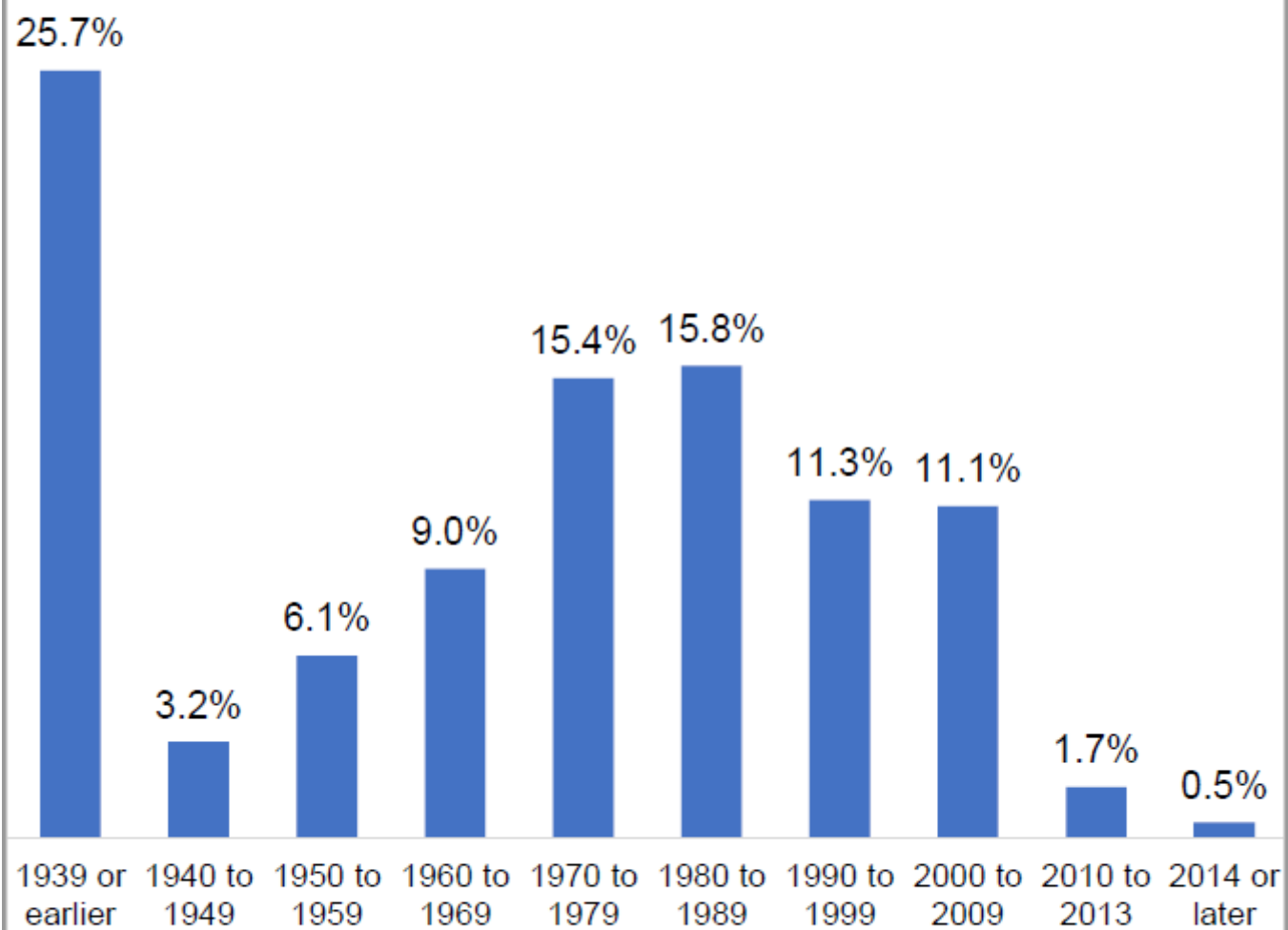






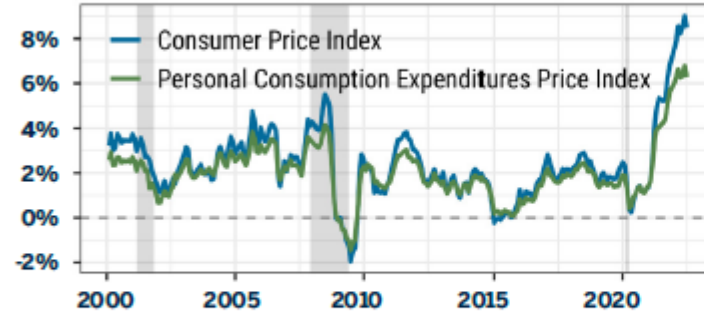

Housing units by year structure built



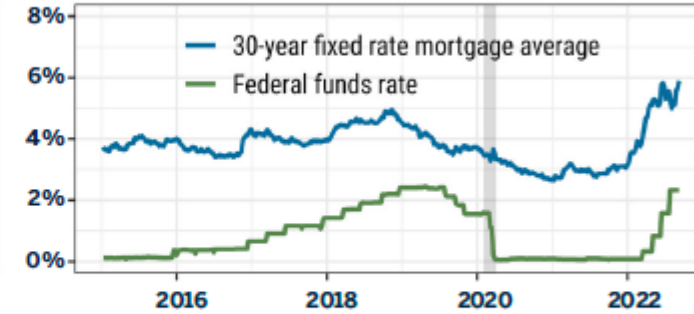
