





### Household growth creates long-term demand


Household growth, 2010-2020




#### Homelessness in VT



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#### Homeownership rate by race




## **Vermont's Aging Housing Stock**

Estimated housing units by year structure built








• Material & Labor are primary drivers of increases

Vermont Housing Finance Agency

- Regulatory/Permitting environment and infrastructure limitations are still identified as systemic issues that need focus.
- Early national study indicators support Vermont's experience of 30% total increases during the Pandemic.

## 15% of all Vermont households spend more than HALF of income for housing



**37,755** Vermont households severely costburdened




Year home was built
